Dear parents and carers,

On Friday 23 July, the Premier announced the addition of Blacktown and Cumberland local government areas (LGAs) to the list of LGAs that have increased COVID restrictions.

This means that residents in these LGAs can only leave their homes for a reasonable excuse. **Tregear Public School is in the Blacktown LGA and this order applies to our school's families.**

Given these new restrictions, I want to repeat our earlier advice that we strongly encourage all parents and carers to keep their children learning from home. Our school will remain open only for students who need it. We will continue to operate with minimum staff on site.

Our teachers will be uploading additional video and live lessons through ClassDojo and Google Classroom to provide further support to our students learning from home. Please ensure you are connected to these digital platforms so that you can access these additional supports and communicate with your child's teacher.
