How to play guess my number:

- 1. Write the numbers from 1 to 10 (for example) on a piece of paper
- 2. Ask someone at home to choose a secret number within your given range. They can't tell you the number.
- 3. Guess their number
- 4. They will tell you if their number is greater or less than your guess
- 5. Try and guess the secret number with few guesses





Numberblocks - Stampolines

Stampolines is a game played by number block characters made out of the same number of blocks as their name, for example two is made out of 2 blocks. They can rearrange themselves into different shapes.



- 2. Carefully cut out your foot.




Exploring Measurement and Geometry

- Find some things that are less than your 7 feet tall. Write or draw these in your workbook.






After playing 'Counting game 24':


- How could we change the game to make it more/less challenging?



















Now it's your turn to create a poster about water.

Go Fish - relationships

That's okay if you can't watch it. The instructions are on the next slide!

- Each player gets 7 cards. The rest of the cards are placed in a pile in the middle.
- Players try to make pairs that are 1 more, 1 less, 2 more, or 2 less. For example:-





- Once they can't make any more pairs, they can take turns to ask their opponent
 - o If their opponent has a card of that number they must give it to the asking player
 - If they don't, they say 'Go Fish' and the player gets a card from the central pile of cards.
- Play continues until one player has no more cards left in their hand. They are the winner!

For those that like a challenge!

- Play the game until there are no cards left.
- · Play the game so that the player with the most pairs is the winner.





Maths- Activity 2- Build your towers.






Roll the die, count out the same number of blocks. Place them on the square to make tower that has the same number of blocks as the number on the card.






Keep rolling and building until you have made all your towers.














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


